Decisions:

Clark County Food Bank was approved as the next quarter **Change for the World** recipient.

Annual Pledge Campaign (APC) will send a connector to all groups of the church. The Pledge Campaign takes place between March 16 and April 12.

Seed Swap on April 27th was approved. Deborah will follow up with Kelly. We discussed the fact that this is the day of a Congregational Meeting between services and we don't wish to draw anyone away from that meeting.
